

**BEFORE THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS**

**IN THE MATTER OF:**

**Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S.**

**ORDER**

On this day comes on for hearing the matter of Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners appeared together by a quorum of its membership together with its attorney, William H. Trice III, and Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. appeared together with his attorney, Jerry Ryan. From the pleadings, evidence introduced, agreement of the parties and argument of counsel, the Board finds that:

1. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. is a licensed dentist in the State of Arkansas under the provisions of the Dental Practice Act.

2. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. is practicing dentistry by and through the name of Bella Vista Dental Clinic, Inc.

3. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. had not registered the corporation, Bella Vista Dental Clinic, Inc., with the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners, thus violating Ark. Code Ann. § 4-29-408 of the Dental Corporation Act.

4. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. was practicing dentistry and holding himself out to the public with a fictitious name and one that did not contain the family name of the dentist; with said name having not been registered with the Board. Said actions violate Ark. Code Ann. § 17-82-316(3)(d) by violating Article VI(b)(1) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board.

5. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. was practicing dentistry through a corporation which did not contain the name of one of the

shareholders in the name of the corporation, thus violating Ark. Code Ann. § 4-29-405 of the Dental Corporation Act.

5. Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-208(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act provides that an administrative board and a party before the Board can reach informal disposition of an issue by stipulation, settlement, consent order or default.

6. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners and Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. have agreed that the Practice Act has been violated as stated hereinabove and that the sanction or punishment for said violation should be as follows:

- a. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. will be placed on probation for 60 days or shorter if he has come into compliance with the Dental Corporation Act, the Dental Practice Act, and the Rules and Regulations of the Board, in utilizing his corporate name.
- b. That he will pay a fine to the Board in the amount of \$600.00.

**WHEREFORE IT IS CONSIDERED ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT:**

1. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. has violated the Dental Practice Act, more specifically, Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-82-316(3)(d) that is advertising that was not in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Board, more specifically, Article VI (b)(1), in that he has not registered a fictitious name with the Board;

2. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. has violated Arkansas Code Annotated § 4-29-405, that is operating a dental corporation which

does not have the name of one of the shareholders in the name of the corporation;

3. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S. has violated Arkansas Code Annotated § 4-29-408 in that he is operating a dental corporation that has not received a Certificate of Registration from the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners.

4. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S., as a result of the violations hereinabove and the agreement of the parties, will be placed on probation for 60 days or shorter if he complies with the Dental Corporation Act, the Dental Practice Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Board;

5. Noble S. Dallison, D.D.S., further, will be fined \$600.00. Said fine is due and payable.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
