

BEFORE THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS

IN THE MATTER OF: DAVID WAYNE VANWINKLE, D.D.S.

ORDER

On this 6th day of December, 1996, comes on for hearing the matter of **David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S.** The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners appeared together by a quorum of its membership, together with its attorney, William H. Trice, III; **David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S.** appeared *pro se*. From the pleadings, testimony of the witnesses and evidence introduced, the Board finds that:

1. **David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S.** is licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas under the provisions of the Dental Practice Act.
2. **David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S.** has failed to provide proof to the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners that he has completed forty (40) hours of continuing dental education that he received for the years 1994 and 1995, in order to retain his license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas for the year 1996.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S. has violated the Dental Practice Act, more specifically, Ark. Code Ann. § 17-80-104, in that he failed to provide proof that he complied with the continuing education requirements of the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners; and Ark. Code Ann. § 17-82-316(B)(3)(f) in that he violated a rule or regulation of the Board, more specifically Article XIV requiring him to file proof of forty (40) hours of continuing dental education prior to his being relicensed to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas in the year 1996.

As a result of the above violation of the Dental Practice Act, **David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S.** is sanctioned by ordering him to pay a fine to the office of the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners of \$300 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.

As a further sanction, **David Wayne VanWinkle, D.D.S.** will provide written proof to the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order of the subject matter of the forty (40) hours of continuing dental education that he received during the years 1994 and 1995, to include the subject matter of the course, the instructor of the course, the location that the course was taken by him, and the date the course was taken by him, with independent proof being provided other than his statement.

It is further ordered that if this is not received, that he will be unable to renew his license for the year 1997.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
