



## MINUTES OF THE MEETING November 4, 2005

On the 4<sup>th</sup> of November 2005, Dr. E. Wayne Looney, President, called the meeting of the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners to order. The following members were present:

Executive Director Donna Cobb and Attorney William Trice were also present.

Dr. Gene Jines asked to speak to the Board concerning a request from Dr. Lindy Bollen. Dr. Bollen is requesting reinstatement of his dental license. A motion was made and seconded to have Dr. Bollen appear at the November 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. The motion passed.

Dr. Andrew Briese appeared before the Board requesting a dental license by examination. Dr. Briese has relocated to Arkansas from Louisiana and does not qualify for licensure by credentials. After a brief interview, a motion was made and seconded to enter into a Consent Order with Dr. Briese to allow him to practice in the State of Arkansas and take the SRTA examination within eighteen months. The motion passed.

Ms. Jennifer Yale, also relocated from Louisiana, appeared before the Board requesting a dental hygiene license by examination. Ms. Yale graduated from

LSU in 2003 and does not qualify for licensure by credentials. During Ms. Yale's interview, she informed the Board that she may have a job at the VA Hospital in Memphis. The Board agreed to table her application until the next meeting.

Next on the agenda was a credentials interview for a dental license submitted by Dr. Jorge Schwarz. With most paperwork in, a motion was made and seconded to issue a license to Dr. Schwarz pending receipt of his National Board Card, a second letter of recommendation and allow him eighteen months to pay the application fee. The motion passed.

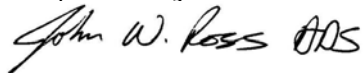
