

BEFORE THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS

IN RE: IN THE MATTER OF DR. PHILIP KHNG

CONSENT ORDER

On this day comes for hearing the matter of Dr. Philip Khng, D.D.S. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners appeared by a quorum of its membership together with its attorney, William H. Trice. Dr. Philip Khng appeared *pro se*. From the application for licensure filed by Philip Khng, D.D.S., statements of Philip Khng, D.D.S., agreement of the parties, the Board finds that:

I.

Philip Khng, D.D.S. applied for a license by credentials to the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners in order to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas.

II.

The application contained information that he entered into an agreement with a sister state not to practice orthodontic dentistry in order to retain a license to practice dentistry in that state.

III.

Pursuant to A.C.A. § 25-25-208(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act, Dr. Philip Khng, D.D.S. makes the following offer to the Board.

1. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners would issue a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas to Philip Khng, D.D.S., based on his application.
 2. Philip Khng, D.D.S. will agree to limit his practice of dentistry by not providing any orthodontic services to his patients.
 3. Philip Khng, D.D.S. further agrees that a violation of the terms of this agreement will be considered as a violation of this Consent Order and subject him to a disciplinary hearing before the Board at which time, the Board could revoke or suspend his license or impose
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other sanctions as provided by Arkansas law.

IV.


Pursuant to ACA § 25-15-208(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act, the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners finds that the offer of Philip Khng, D.D.S., stated in paragraph III above, is a fair and equitable agreement and protects the health and safety of the citizens of Arkansas and the rights of Philip Khng, D.D.S.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners adopts by reference as if set out word for word herein, the agreement of the parties stated in paragraph III and IV above, as the Board's own Order.
2. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners issues to Philip Khng, D.D.S., a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas, with the understanding that he is to refrain from providing orthodontic services to patients.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




