

BEFORE THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS
IN THE MATTER OF WILLIAM JARROD STEWART, D.D.S.

CONSENT ORDER

On this 15th day of September, 2000 comes on for hearing the matter of William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners appeared together by a quorum of its' membership together with its' attorney, William H. Trice, III. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. appeared *pro se*. From the pleadings, Application for Licensure and exhibits to said application, and agreement of the parties, the Board finds that:

1. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has applied for a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas.
2. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has admitted in testimony that he was licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Louisiana in June of 1998, and that he surrendered said license one year later as a result of his having a substance abuse problem.
3. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has undergone in-house treatment and out patient therapy and monitoring for his substance abuse problem; and has been drug-free for one year.
4. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has successfully completed all exams required for licensure in the State of Arkansas, to include the Clinical Exam with the Southern Regional Testing Agency, successfully passed in December, 1999.
5. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners has stated that it would not issue a license to practice dentistry to William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. due to his previous substance abuse problem without certain protections and safeguards.

6. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has offered to the Board, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §25-15-208(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act, an offer to resolve the issues pending before the Board as follows:

- A. The Board will issue to William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas.
- B. The license to practice dentistry of William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. in the State of Arkansas will remain valid and operational for so long as William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. complies with the terms of this Agreement.
- C. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will attend four (4) Narcotics Anonymous or similar programs of after care meetings per week and will provide proof to the Board of said attendance on forms that the Board Office will approve of.
- D. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will continue to receive counseling from his Psychologist, Dr. Linda Dyer Hartsfield, on a regular basis and will instruct and authorize Dr. Hartsfield to provide the Board with any information concerning the counseling, and submit to the Board, quarterly narrative reports as to Dr. Stewart's suitability to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas and his progress in dealing with his substance abuse problem.
- E. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will enter into a contract with P & L Drug Monitoring Programs and will comply with the terms of said contract. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will further authorize P & L Drug Monitoring Programs to provide to the Board such regular information as to his compliance or non-compliance with the drug monitoring program.


- F. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will keep the Board informed as to his location of practice and the name of other licensees with whom he will practice.
- G. The costs of the monitoring program and out-of-pocket costs incurred by the Board Office will be paid by William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S.
- H. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will appear before the Board to give reports as to his compliance or non-compliance with this substance abuse monitoring program as the Board may require.
- I. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will obey and comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Board and the Dental Practice Act.
- J. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will refrain from the use of schedule medication or alcohol or other mind-altering substances unless the same is prescribed by a physician or dentist for a medical or dental reason, and he will communicate to the Board Office and to P & L Monitoring Program the use of said medications.
- K. That this Agreement will remain in full force and effect for a period of five (5) years and that upon William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. complying with the terms of this Agreement for five (5) years, he will have an unencumbered license to practice dentistry. His failure to comply with the terms of this agreement will cause his license to be suspended or revoked as the Board may determine at that time.

7. The Board finds that it is in the best interests of the applicant and the State of Arkansas to accept the agreement as stated hereinabove.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. be granted a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas subject to the terms of the Agreement as stated in Paragraph 6 above.



CONSENT ORDER

On this 22ND day of June, 2001 comes on for hearing the matter of William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners appeared together by a quorum of its' membership together with its' attorney, William H. Trice, III. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. appeared together with his attorney, Gary Rogers. From the pleadings, testimony of the witnesses and evidence introduced the Board finds that:

1. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. is a licensed dentist practicing in the State of Arkansas under the provisions of the Dental Practice Act.
2. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. entered into a Consent Order with the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners dated October 18, 2000. In said Order, William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. was granted a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas for so long as William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. complied with the terms of that order. Paragraph 6J of the Consent Order provided that William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. would refrain from the use of scheduled medication, alcohol or other mind altering drugs.
3. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has admitted in testimony, and it has been corroborated by monitoring reports, that he tested positive for cocaine in a random drug sample on March 26, 2001.
4. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has testified and admitted in testimony that he has an addiction problem for which he has sought professional help and treatment.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. has violated the Dental Practice Act, more specifically,

Arkansas Code Ann. § 17-82-316(B)(3)(C) that is he has exhibited the addiction to narcotics or scheduled medication.

2. As a result of the above violation of the Dental Practice Act, the license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas, William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. is Revoked. Said revocation is stayed for so long as William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. complies with the terms of stay for a period of five years as follows:

A. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will pay to the Board within twelve months from the date of this Order a fine of \$1,000.00.

B. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will enter into a contract for monitoring with P & L Drug Screen Monitoring and will comply with the terms of said contract as if they were terms of this Stay of Revocation.

C. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will authorize P & L Drug Screen Monitoring to provide to the Board timely information as to his compliance or non-compliance of the drug monitoring program. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will pay the costs of said drug monitoring.

D. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will attend four to five Narcotics Anonymous or similar programs/meetings per week and will provide proof of attendance to the Board office.

E. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will refrain from the use of scheduled medication, alcohol or other mind altering substances unless the same is prescribed by a physician or dentist for a medical or dental reason. If the same is prescribed for him, he will communicate that to the Board office and the P & L monitoring program prior to drug testing.

F. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will continue to receive counseling from a psychiatrist and a psychologist and will authorize his treating therapists to provide quarterly reports to the Board as to his suitability and capability of practicing dentistry in the State of Arkansas.

G. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will complete and provide proof of completion of his outpatient program for chemical dependency at the Bridgeway Hospital.

H. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will provide proof to the Board of his sponsor in his NA or similar type substance abuse rehabilitation program.

I. William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. will keep the Board informed as to the location of his practice and names of licensees with whom he will practice.

Upon William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. complying with terms of stay as stated hereinabove, for a period of five years, his license will become unencumbered. If William Jarrod Stewart, D.D.S. fails to comply with the terms of the stay as listed hereinabove, his license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas will be revoked.





IN THE MATTER OF WILLIAM JARROD STEWART, D.D.S.

CONSENT ORDER

On this 18th day of February, 2005 comes on for hearing the matter of William Jarrod Stewart, DDS. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners appeared together by a quorum of its membership, together with its attorney, William H. Trice. William Jarrod Stewart, DDS, appeared with this attorney, Clayton Blackstock. From the pleadings and agreement of the parties, the Board finds that:

1. William Jarrod Stewart, DDS is licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas pursuant to the provisions of the Dental Practice Act.

2. The Board entered an Emergency Order of Suspension of the license to practice dentistry of William Jarrod Stewart, DDS and a Notice of Hearing dated 7 October, 2004. Said Order alleged that William Jarrod Stewart, DDS had violated the Dental Practice Act, more specifically, ACA § 17-82-316(3)(c), that is, he exhibited an addiction to narcotics, and ACA § 17-82-316(g), that is, he violated a previous Order of the Board, more specifically, the Order of 8 August, 2001.

3. Pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, ACA § 25-15-208(b), William Jarrod Stewart, DDS, by and through his attorney, Clayton Blackstock, has made the following offer to the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners, to enter into a Consent Order with the Board with the following provisions:

a. William Jarrod Stewart, DDS would acknowledge in said Order that he had violated the Dental Practice Act, more specifically, ACA § 17-82-316(3)(c), that is, he exhibited an addiction

to narcotics, and ACA § 17-82-316(g), that is, he violated a previous Order of the Board, that being the Order of 8 August, 2001.

b. The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners would revoke the license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas of William Jarrod Stewart, DDS. Said revocation would be stayed for a period of five years for so long as William Jarrod Stewart, DDS complies with the following conditions of stay:

(i) William Jarrod Stewart, DDS would enter into a contract for monitoring and rehabilitation with the Arkansas Medical Foundation and would comply with the terms of that contract.

(ii) The terms of the contract with the Arkansas Medical Foundation would be the conditions of stay for this Consent Order.

(iii) William Jarrod Stewart, DDS would continue to receive psychiatric treatment and would authorize his treating psychiatrist to provide the Board reports on a quarterly basis to include a diagnosis of his condition, type of treatment prescribed, his ability to continue to practice dentistry, and his compliance with his treatment plan.

(iv) William Jarrod Stewart would attend all meetings of the Board to discuss compliance with the Consent Order until excused from said requirement.

(v) He would provide a copy of this Consent Order to any employers or co-workers so that they would be aware of his monitoring program with the Board.

4. Upon William Jarrod Stewart, DDS complying with the conditions of stay of this Consent Order for a period of five years, his license would become unencumbered, for so long as he maintains a license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas, William Jarrod Stewart would continue under a contract for rehabilitation with the Arkansas Medical Foundation and would

comply with the terms of that contract. Upon William Jarrod Stewart, DDS failing to comply with the conditions of stay, his license to practice dentistry in the State of Arkansas will be revoked.

5. Pursuant to ACA § 25-15-208(b), The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners agrees with the terms of the Consent Order as proposed by William Jarrod Stewart, DDS

WHEREFORE, it is considered, ordered, and adjudged that the agreement of the parties as stated hereinabove in Paragraphs 3 and 4 is a fair and equitable agreement, and protects the health and safety of the citizens of Arkansas, and the rights of William Jarrod Stewart, DDS. The Court adopts the terms of said agreement as the Board's own Order.




